From Hartford Area:

Take I-91S to Exit 6 – Willow Street. At the end of the ramp, take a right onto Willow Street. Proceed on Willow Street until you reach the end (Whitney Avenue). Make a left onto Whitney Avenue. At the second traffic light, make a right onto Edwards Street. First intersection is St. Ronan Street and CSMS building is on the corner. Proceed past St. Ronan Street intersection and turn right to the first driveway, just past the building. Enter building at parking lot door.

From New London Area:

Take I-95S to I-91N to Exit 3 – Trumbull Street. At the end of the ramp, go straight. At the next light, take a right onto Whitney Avenue. Proceed on Whitney Avenue to your third traffic light. Take a left onto Edwards Street. CSMS is up one block on the right, with the entrance to the parking lot on the right just past the building. (The first driveway on the right, after the intersection with St. Ronan Street.)

From Fairfield Area:

Take I-95N to I-91N to Exit 3 – Trumbull Street. At the end of the ramp, go straight. At the next light, take a right onto Whitney Avenue. Proceed on Whitney Avenue to your third traffic light. Take a left onto Edwards Street. CSMS is up one block on the right, with the entrance to the parking lot on the right just past and behind the building. (The first driveway on the right, after the intersection with St. Ronan Street.)

From Danbury Area:

Take I-84E to Route 8S to Exit 15 – Route 34E. Turn right at the end of the exit. Go over the bridge and at the traffic light turn right onto 34E. Follow signs for Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15N). Take Route 15N to Exit 61 (Whitney Avenue to New Haven). At the end of the exit, go left. Stay on Whitney Avenue for 4-5 miles. Turn right at the traffic light at Edwards Street. CSMS is up one block on the right, with the entrance to the parking lot on the right just past the building. (The first driveway on the right, after the intersection with St. Ronan Street.)

From Waterbury Area:

Take Route 8S to Exit 15 – Route 34E. Turn right at the end of the exit. Go over the bridge and at the traffic light turn right onto 34E. Follow signs for Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15N). Take Route 15N to Exit 61 (Whitney Avenue to New Haven). At the end of the exit, go left. Stay on Whitney Avenue for 4-5 miles. Turn right at the traffic light at Edwards Street. CSMS is up one block on the right, with the entrance to the parking lot on the right just past the building. (The first driveway on the right, after the intersection with St. Ronan Street.)
