Stop the Bleed Training Certification (Thursday evening following reception.)

Uncontrolled bleeding is a major cause of preventable deaths. Approximately 40% of trauma-related deaths worldwide are due to bleeding or its consequences. Average time to bleed out: 3 to 5 minutes. Average time for 1st responders to arrive: 7 to 10 minutes. Bystanders can fill the gap with STOP THE BLEED. Become certified to train bystanders bleeding control techniques including application of a tourniquet.

Narcan Review (Thursday evening following reception.)

Learn what makes opioids unique. Identify an overdose. Demonstrate Narcan administration. Learn about the new threats.
